13TH ANNUAL TRI-TIP COOK-OFF

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The decisions and interpretations of the Tri-Tip Cook-Off Rules and Regulations are at the discretion of the Tri-Tip Cook-Off Representatives. Their decisions and interpretations are final.
- 2. Team sponsors must be identified at the time of registration.
- 3. A maximum of 15 entrants will be accepted on a first received, first serve basis for all Cook-Off categories. Cook-Off space will be assigned at the time of registration. All grills and other equipment used by the team must remain within the assigned cooking space.
- 4. Contestants must follow all local, fire, electrical, health, and other appropriate local codes. All contestants must review the Imperial County Public Health

 Department Temporary Food Facility guidelines. Information may be found online at: https://www.icphd.org/assets.Environmental-Health/Food/Food-Applications/Temporary-Food-Facility-Application-9-09-2024.pdf
- 5. One day permit will be obtained from Imperial County Public Health Department, Division of Environmental Health, by the City of Imperial. All food items must be identified on the Tri-Tip Cook-Off Application for required Health Department permit. Food items not listed on the Tri-Tip Cook-Off Application will not be allowed.
- 6. All participating Tri-Tip Cook-Off teams are required to obtain a City of Imperial Business License for all business and sales transacted within the City of Imperial.
- 7. THERE WILL BE A MANDATORY PARTICIPANT MEETING ON TUESDAY, MARCH 18TH AT 6:00 PM FOR ALL CHIEF COOKS/TEAM LEADERS.
- 8. Teams shall provide their own meat, cooking ingredients, individual cooking devices, equipment, preparation tables, hot coal catching pan, shade, etc. as needed or required for the Cook-Off.
- 9. One person is to be designated as the Team Leader or Chief Cook. The Team Leader or Chief Cook will attend the Cook's Meeting and will be responsible for all actions of the team. Only team members may assist with and be in the designated cooking space and/ or designated meat cutting areas.
- 10. Check—in time starts at 8:00 AM on Saturday, March 22, 2025. Vehicles will be allowed in the event area for set—up until 12:00 PM.
- 11. There will be a MANDATORY Cook's Meeting at 10:00 AM at the Veteran's Memorial Hall.
- 12. The Tri-Tip Cook-Off will be held from 4:00 PM-9:00 PM. People's Choice ballots will be accepted from 4:00 PM-7:30 PM. (In order to keep event on schedule, People's Choice ballots cannot be accepted after 7:30 PM.)
- 13. Judging will begin at 2:00 PM. Results will be announced at 7:45 PM.
- 14. All competition meat shall start out raw and stored at a temperature of 40 degrees or less (packed with ice in an ice chest or in a refrigerator).
- 15. Competition meat may be pre-seasoned at an approved kitchen facility. Teams must list the approved kitchen on Temporary Food Facility Permit Application.
- 16. Tri-Tip samples, sides, plate dishes, and beverages may be sold for Tri-Tip Cook-Off tickets only and may not be given away or sold for cash.
- 17. Tri-Tip Cook-Off tickets will be sold by the City of Imperial to the public for \$2 each with 70% of the sales going back to the participating teams.
 - Each team will be provided with an enclosed box that contains the team number to hold collected tickets. Teams will turn in collected tickets to the City of Imperial Tri-Tip Cook-Off booth by 9:00 PM to be tabulated for reimbursement. People's Choice tickets collected in your booth's box will not count towards reimbursement. Reimbursement will be provided by the City of Imperial within three weeks of the Tri-Tip Cook-Off.
- 18. All teams are required to provide the City of Imperial a completed W-9 form. Reimbursement checks will not be disbursed without the required form.
- 19. <u>Judging:</u> Contestants must submit at least (6) six cuts of Tri-Tip meat, enough for all six judges, to the judging area at the Veteran's Memorial Hall.
 - Turn in times will be drawn and assigned at the Cook's Meeting. The allowable turn-in time will be (5) five minutes before to (5) five minutes after the posted time. A late turn-in will not be accepted by Tri-Tip Cook-Off Representatives and will receive a (0) zero in all judging criteria.
 - Judging will be based upon appearance, tenderness, and taste.
 - Meat shall not be sculpted, branded, or presented in any way to make it identifiable. Rosettes of meat slices are not allowed. Violations of this rule will be scored a (1) one in all criteria from all (6) six judges.
 - Garnish is optional. If used, it is limited to chopped, sliced, shredded, or whole leaves of fresh green lettuce, curly parsley or kale, flat leaf parsley. Any other garnish shall receive a penalty score of (1) one in the category of appearance.
 - Entries will be submitted in a numbered container supplied by the City of Imperial. The number must be on the top of the container during the time of turn—in. The container shall not be marked in any way so as to make the container unique or identifiable. Aluminum foil, toothpicks, skewers, foreign material, and/or stuffing are prohibited in the container. Marked entries or containers with the above listed material will receive (1) one in all criteria from all (6) six judges and will be disqualified.
 - Each contestant must submit at least (6) portions of meat in an approved container. Judges may not cut, slice, or shake apart to separate pieces. If there is not enough meat for each judge to sample, the shorted judge(s) will score a (1) one on all criteria, and the judges that receive samples will change the appearance score to (1) one as a penalty.
- 20. <u>People's Choice Award:</u> Teams must provide tri–tip for at least 1,000 people. Tri–tip samples should be approximately (2) two ounces per sample, a minimum of 125 pounds of meat is required to participate in the Cook–Off. During the time of check–in at 8:00 AM, the Team Leader or Chief Cook will be required to provide the receipt for proof of the purchase of 125 pounds of meat that will be used for the Tri–Tip Cook–Off. The team will provide (1) one, 2–ounce sample, in exchange for (1) ticket. Attendees will receive (1) one People's Choice voting ballot per purchase of (5) five Tri–Tip Cook–Off tickets. Attendees may cast their vote for their favorite team at the People's Choice voting booth from 4:00 PM to 7:30 PM. The team with the most votes will win the People's Choice Award.
- 21. <u>Best BBQ Inspired Side Dish Award:</u> Contestants will submit (1) one side dish as (6) six individual portions, enough for all six judges, to the judging area at the Veteran's Memorial Hall. Entries must be submitted in a numbered container supplied by the City of Imperial. Judging will be based on appearance, taste, originality, and food (Tri-Tip) pairing. Teams are encouraged to write the name of the side dish on the container or where visible.
- 22. <u>Best BBQ Inspired Beverage Award:</u> Contestants will submit (1) one BBQ-inspired beverage as (6) six individual portions, enough for all six judges, to the judging area at the Veteran's Memorial Hall. Judging will be based on appearance, taste, originality, and choice of barbecued key ingredient(s). The BBQ-inspired beverage must contain at least one key barbequed ingredient. Judges will ask for the key ingredient(s) to be identified during the assigned turn-in time.
