## **RESOLUTION NO. 2025-01**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IMPERIAL, CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING A 5% STIPEND FOR THE CROSS-CONNECTION CONTROL PROGRAM COORDINATOR

WHEREAS, the State Water Resources Control Board adopted a Cross-Connection Control Policy Handbook on 12/19/2023 which became effective 07/01/2024, to protect public health by establishing standards to ensure a public water system's drinking water distribution system is not subject to the backflow of liquids, gases or other substances. This handbook contains standards for backflow protection and cross-connection control; and

WHEREAS, the Cross-Connection Control Program requires a Cross-Connection Control Program Coordinator to be designated that is responsible for reporting, tracking, and other administration duties of the Cross-Connection Control Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Imperial, California (hereinafter referred to as the "City"), is seeking to appoint a Cross-Connection Control Program Coordinator for the City's Cross-Connection Control Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cross-Connection Control Program Coordinator will be appointed by the Public Services Director or designee of the City Manager; and

**WHEREAS**, the designated Cross-Connection Program Coordinator possesses the following qualifications, demonstrating their exceptional ability to contribute significantly to the City:

- Is certified as a Cross-Connection Control Program Specialist in good standing;
- Knowledgeable about cross-connection control, and ability to identify actual and potential hazards:
- Ability to apply principles of backflow protection and prevention, and implement cross-connection control policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the appointed Cross-Connection Control Program Coordinator will be entrusted with additional duties beyond their required regular position, requiring them to utilize their knowledge and expertise in cross-connection control; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Imperial, California, as follows:

- 1. **Findings.** Council hereby finds that all recitals are true and correct. The Council also finds the need for additional duties that the staff designated as the Cross-Connection Control Program Coordinator shall perform in addition to their regular duties.
- 2. **Stipend Authorization.** The City Council hereby authorizes a 5% stipend to be added to the base salary of the designated Cross-Connection Control Program Coordinator, in recognition

of the additional duties in which they are qualified and shall perform, and anticipated contributions to the City.

3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
