Vehicle Summary 1997 Ford F250 Bucket Truck (28 years old) Mileage 108,750

In 2021 this vehicle was a transfer in from the Public Services Department to the Parks Department. The P.S. department was getting ready to replace this bucket truck with a newer version. Parks Department was asked if we would like to get the last few years of use out the bucket truck rather than surplus it at the time. We agreed and transferred it over. For the first year the bucket truck served it's purpose and had the department had no issues. Then systematically the truck started experiencing issues with the engine following by the aerial component often swinging to fast or slow and remaining stuck in the air at dangerous heights. The department has taken the vehicle to several local shops to fix the issues at great expense with no success. The recommendations have been to replace the aerial component completely which exceeds the value of the vehicle. It is for these reasons stated above that we recommend the surplus of the bucket truck.

Vehicle Summary 1999 Ford F250 U haul Box Truck (26 years old) Mileage 229,224

This Vehicle has been historically used to store items for special events. In the last 2 years the vehicle has had several mechanical issues and the catalytic converter was stolen. The department has also outgrown the use of the vehicle for the purpose of special event storage. The costs to replace the catalytic converter and make the engine repairs necessary exceeds 50% of the vehicles value. The Department recommends the surplus of the Box Truck for the above stated reasons.
