 AUTHORIZE CHANGE ORDER #2 TO MITIGATE UNFORESEEN SERIOUS CONDITIONS OF VARIOUS CITY'S ESSENTIAL INFRASTRUCTURE COMPONENTS.

DEPARTMENT INVOLVED: COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

Community Development Department was directed by City Council per Agenda Item CC02-07-24_B-2 to seek Bids for the Townsite Street Improvements Project. Thereafter, through a formal competitive Bid process, City Council awarded a contract to Rove Engineering, Inc. to complete the construction of said project per Agenda Item CC05-01-24 C-2.

Since then, city staff have been working closely with Rove Engineering, Inc. to ensure both, the proper execution of the items included in the authorized Proposal Bid Sheet, and also find expeditious, efficient and affordable solutions for the many challenges that have arisen daily due to the advanced age of the existing infrastructure and components that are not listed in the City's records.

This Change Order is taking care of unanticipated removal and replacement of sanitary sewer and water mains and its residential connections, as well as various adjustments of the existing infrastructure.

Contractor is directed to make the following change(s) to the original contract:

Add the following new items:

- I. Unanticipated removal and replacement of 8-in sanitary sewer mains and its residential laterals.
 - Original scope of work only included the removal and replacement of sanitary sewer manholes within 7th, 10th & 14th Streets. During the installation of said manholes it was discovered that some of the adjacent sewer mains, installed long time ago using vitrified clay pipes (VCP), were in very poor conditions, some even already presenting cracks and fissures. After further inspections completed by City Staff and contractor, the situation was discussed among Community Development Department, Public Services Department and our contractor during our regular weekly construction progress. Then, it was decided to remove and replace the segment of sanitary sewer mains, as well as its residential laterals directly below the area being improved due to the high risk of this pipeline collapsing in the immediate future due to the programmed asphalt rehabilitation work of this project. See Exhibit "A" which illustrates the area.

The investment for this unforeseen task was agreed to be coming from Public Services Department's CIP #858, Old Imperial Wastewater Pipelines.

ii. During the replacement of the sanitary sewer manhole at 14th St & "C" St intersection, the 8" Ø sanitary sewer main going north towards 15th St was discovered to be already damaged and had formed a "valley" (depressed section) causing a disruption and not letting the sewage flow freely towards the manhole. Due to immediate action was required to rectify this difficult situation, Community Development Department, Public Services Department and our contractor met at project site; the group concluded that said sewer main and its residential laterals had to be replaced expeditiously to avoid a crisis. See Exhibit "B" which illustrates the area.

The investment for this unforeseen task was agreed to be coming from Public Services Department's CIP #858, Old Imperial Wastewater Pipelines.

iii. While removing and replacing the sanitary sewer manholes at 7th Street & "H" Street intersection, the section of sanitary sewer main along "H" Street going north up to Barioni Blvd was determined to be in serious conditions. Being said section of roadway part of the "Pavement Rehabilitation of Various Roads Project", the high risk of this pipeline collapsing in the near future due to the programmed asphalt rehabilitation forced City Staff to pay attention to this situation. Community Development Department, Public Services Department and our contractor met at project site for further inspection concluding that the repair should not wait any more due to its severity. To maximize the benefits of this additional work, the manhole located at Barioni Blvd and "H" St intersection was also removed and replaced. See Exhibit "C" which illustrates the area. As a consequence of the emergency triggered by the deterioration found in this segment of sanitary sewer main, which threatened to compromise the safety of our residents, this work was billed on a time and materials basis.

The investment for this unforeseen task was agreed to be coming from Public Services Department's CIP #858 (Old Imperial Wastewater Pipelines) #850 ("H" Street Sewer Line).

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II. Before repaving S "H" St between W Barioni Blvd & W 7th St, as part of the "Pavement Rehabilitation of Various Roads Project", the existing waterline underneath is requested to be removed and replaced for minimizing the risk of failing while repaving, this is due to its old age and type of material.

The investment for this unforeseen task was agreed to be coming from Public Services Department's CIP #859 (Old Imperial Water Pipelines).

IV. In anticipation of rehabilitating the asphalt roadway along "C" Street between 14th St and 15th St, per Exhibit "D", City Staff conducted a field inspection finding that some sections of Curb & Gutter are missing and, therefore should be constructed in advance. Placing Curb & Gutter is very important as is a key component for our streets to avoid premature erosion by protecting pavement edges and ensuring proper drainage by guiding water into storm drains.


