### BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

The County of Imperial Administration Office has allocated \$100,000.02 for FY 2022/2023. The below expenditure plan was developed in connection to the grant requirements. To accept this grant funding, the City is required to adopt a resolution accepting the funds and an expenditure plan outlining the use for those funds. (See Resolution 2024-08)

Expenditure plan outlines the following Public Safety expenditures.

- 1. \$22,075.72: (1) Live Scan Machine
  - Live Scan Machine will be purchased immediately upon approval.
- 2. \$58,989.00: (34) Ballistic Vests
  - Vests will be purchased on an as needed basis throughout the next five years.
- 3. \$38,735.30: New Animal Control Facility
  - Money will be set aside for future purchase. Expected amount of facility is in excess of \$100,000.
