APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION 2024-10 APPROVING AN APPLICATION SUBMISSION TO OBTAIN FUNDING THROUGH THE FY 2023-2024 CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY (CMAQ) IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ATEN BOULEVARD SIDEWALK INSTALLATION PROJECT BETWEEN PROGRESS TRAIL AND OLD SR -86, PHASE I.</p>

<p>BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:</p> <p>The City of Imperial submitted an application through ICTC requesting Federal Funds during Fiscal Year 2023-2024 of the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Improvement Program for the construction of Aten Boulevard Sidewalk Installation Project between Progress Trail and Old SR-86, Phase I.</p> <p>In order to advance our project candidacy, a signed resolution must also be submitted to ICTC and SCAG, formalizing the City's commitment to match the federal funds requested in the amount of 11.47%, as stipulated in the application.</p> <p>This resolution certifies that, if the funding is approved for the above-referenced project, the City of Imperial will commit to match \$18,000.00 or 11.47% of the amount requested, \$132,000.00, giving a total construction amount of \$150,000.00. Since the awarding of the funds by SCAG is anticipated to take place in June 2024, the exact amounts may vary.</p> <p>Please refer to Exhibit A – Resolution No. 2024-10 attached herewith for details.</p>

## RESOLUTION NO. 2024-10

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IMPERIAL APPROVING THE APPLICATION SUBMISSION TO OBTAIN FUNDING THROUGH THE FY 2023-2024 CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY (CMAQ) IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ATEN BOULEVARD SIDEWALK INSTALLATION PROJECT BETWEEN PROGRESS TRAIL AND OLD SR -86, PHASE I.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Imperial is able to apply for and receive Federal and State funding including Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Improvement Program funds; and

**WHEREAS**, AB 1012 requires that state and federal funds be expended in a timely manner; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Imperial desires to ensure that its project are delivered in a timely manner to avoid losing funds for non-delivery; and

**WHEREAS**, it is understood by the City of Imperial that failure for not meeting project milestone dates for any phase of a project may jeopardize federal or state funding to the Region; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Imperial will submit an application for *Aten Boulevard Sidewalk Installation Project Between Progress Trail and Old SR-86, Phase I* with an estimated project construction amount of *\$150,000.00*; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Imperial hereby agrees to ensure that all project milestone schedules for all project phases will be met or exceeded, and:

- a. The opportunity for public comment was provided at a public meeting;
- b. Local funds in the amount of 11.47% from LTA Measure “D” funds will be used to leverage the federal funds for the project;
- c. Project is consistent with circulation element of the agency’s general plan planning process;
- d. Project is consistent with the adopted pavement management plan.
- e. The City Attorney is authorized to make minor typographical changes to this Resolution that does not change the substance of this Resolution;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that failure to meet project delivery deadlines may be deemed as sufficient cause for the Imperial County Transportation Commission Policy Board to terminate an agency’s project and reprogram Federal/State funds as deemed necessary.

The City Attorney is authorized to make minor typographical changes to this Resolution that does not change the substance of this Resolution.
