On behalf of the City of Imperial, I write in support of Assembly Bill 2633, which expands CSU's authority to offer joint degrees with universities internationally. It is especially important to the County of Imperial, which has a cross border population of 8 million annually. Like San Diego County, students travel to and from Mexico to attend college. As Imperial County continues to grow in population, the economy is also growing, particularly in the STEM fields. Most recently, the development of lithium and other minerals has flourished, with billions of dollars in investments. There also is a tremendous need for workers in the healthcare industry, putting tremendous pressure on our local universities and colleges to prepare students to meet these health demands.
