#### BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

Previously approved, was resolution 2024-08 on 03/20/2023 by the Imperial City Council. The County of Imperial Administration Office has notified the Department that we are unable to use the funding for a new animal control shelter. Below is the new expenditure plan for the allocated \$100,000.02 for FY 2022/2023. The below expenditure plan was developed in connection to the grant requirements. To accept this grant funding, the City is required to adopt a resolution accepting the funds and an expenditure plan outlining the use for those funds. (See Resolution 2024-20)

Expenditure plan outlines the following Public Safety expenditures.

- 1. \$22,075.72: (1) Live Scan Machine
  - Live Scan Machine will be purchased immediately upon approval.
- 2. \$58,989.00: (34) Ballistic Vests
  - Vests will be purchased on an as needed basis throughout the next five years.
- 3. \$22,000: (1) Addition body camera's with docking base
  - Items will be purchased immediately upon approval.
- 4. \$16,735: (1) Autel Robotics EVO Max 4N Drone
  - Drone will be an expansion to our current drones with higher capabilities than the ones that were donated. Kit
    comes with drone, case, blades, handheld remote, extra battery with charger. Drone is capable of 3D mapping
    for crime scenes, includes a thermal camera for night time operation, and a range finder.
