Dear Honorable Councilmembers:

Requested Action:

Approve award of contract to Rove Engineering Inc, for Pavement Rehabilitation of Various Roads in the City of Imperial; Bid No. 2024-08.

Background:

On September 12, 2024 the City Clerk publicly opened bids for Bid No. 2024-08.

The work to be done consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor and incidentals as required by the contract documents for road rehabilitation improvements along various roads, consisting of the following scope of work: traffic control around the construction zones, raising/lowering utilities, grinding existing AC pavement, HMA leveling course, install ARAM, and ARHM overlay. New pavement striping and materials testing will be provided by the City.

The City of Imperial Public Services Department, received three (3) bids, which are outlined as follows:

Public Services has determined that the bid submitted by Rove Engineering Inc., is the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder. Therefore, it is requested the project be awarded to Rove Engineering Inc.

Rove Engineering Inc. submitted a combined bid of \$3,399,999.00, including the Base Bid and Additive Bid items. The bid submitted for the project is awarded based on the base bid price. The final amount of the contract will be dependent on the final actual quantities accomplished under each pay item. While "Extra Work" is unlikely, should unforeseen circumstances require it, a change order to the contract may be necessary. The Public Services Director will order any change orders pursuant to Public Contract Code 20142 with prior approval from Council.

Fiscal Impact:

Staff recommends that both the Base Bid and the Additive Bid be awarded if there is funding available. Funds to cover associated street related costs will be expended from General Fund. The costs to raise and lower water valves will be funded through the Water Enterprise Fund. The project costs associated with lowering and raising sewer manholes will be funded through the Sewer Enterprise Fund.

Funds were discovered during FY budget review within the Successor Agency Fund (Fund 94), previously known as the Redevelopment Funds account. Funds were previously mis-allocated on FY18-19, 19-20, 20-21, 21-22, and 22-23. Discussions with Department of Finance resulted in an agreement to reallocate the funds into the General Fund account. Such funds (Redevelopment/Successor Agency) are eligible to be utilized on street maintenance and improvements.

Total Cost for awarding the entire project is **\$3,999,999.00** including the Additive Bid Items. Accounts to be utilized are as follows:

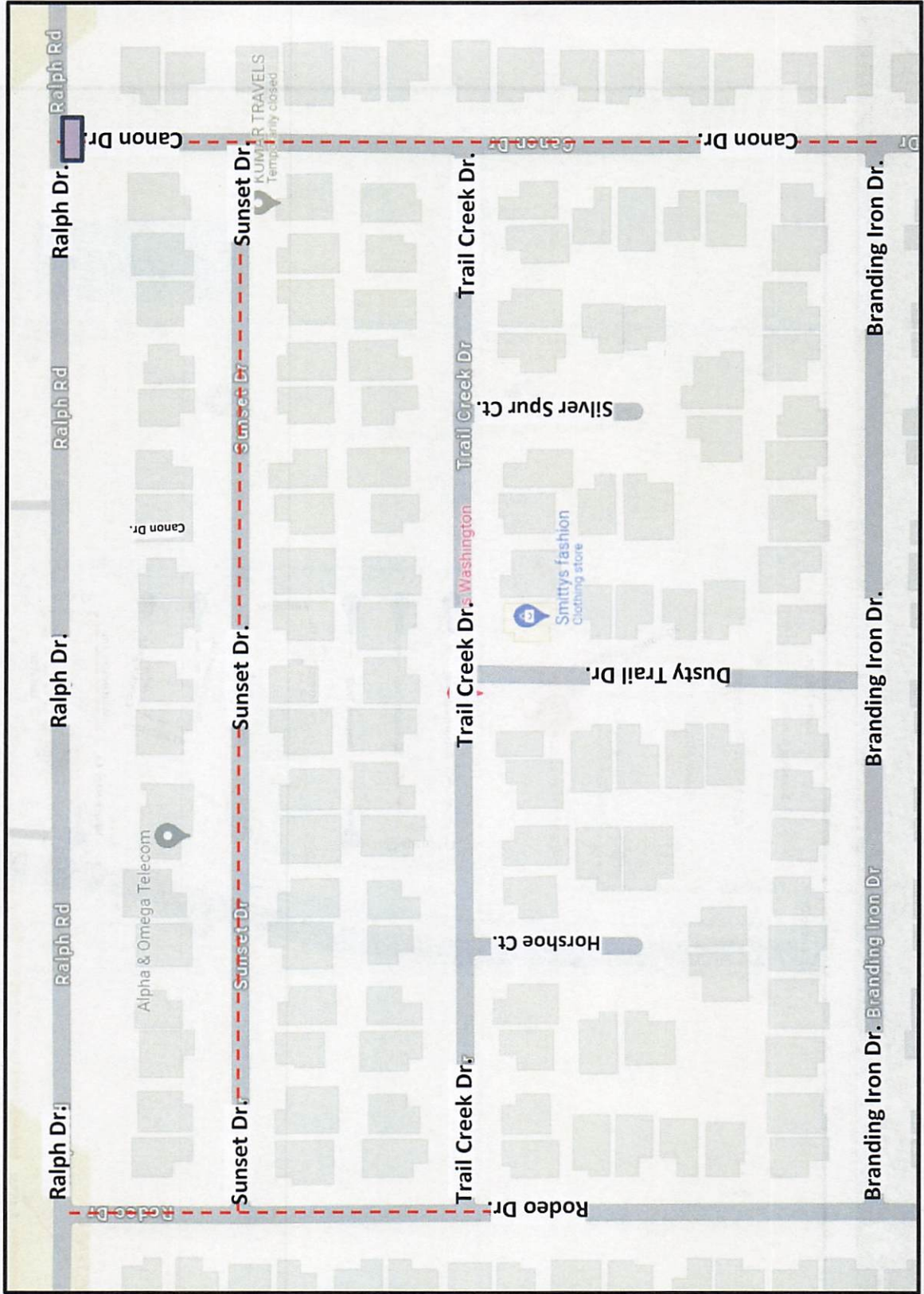

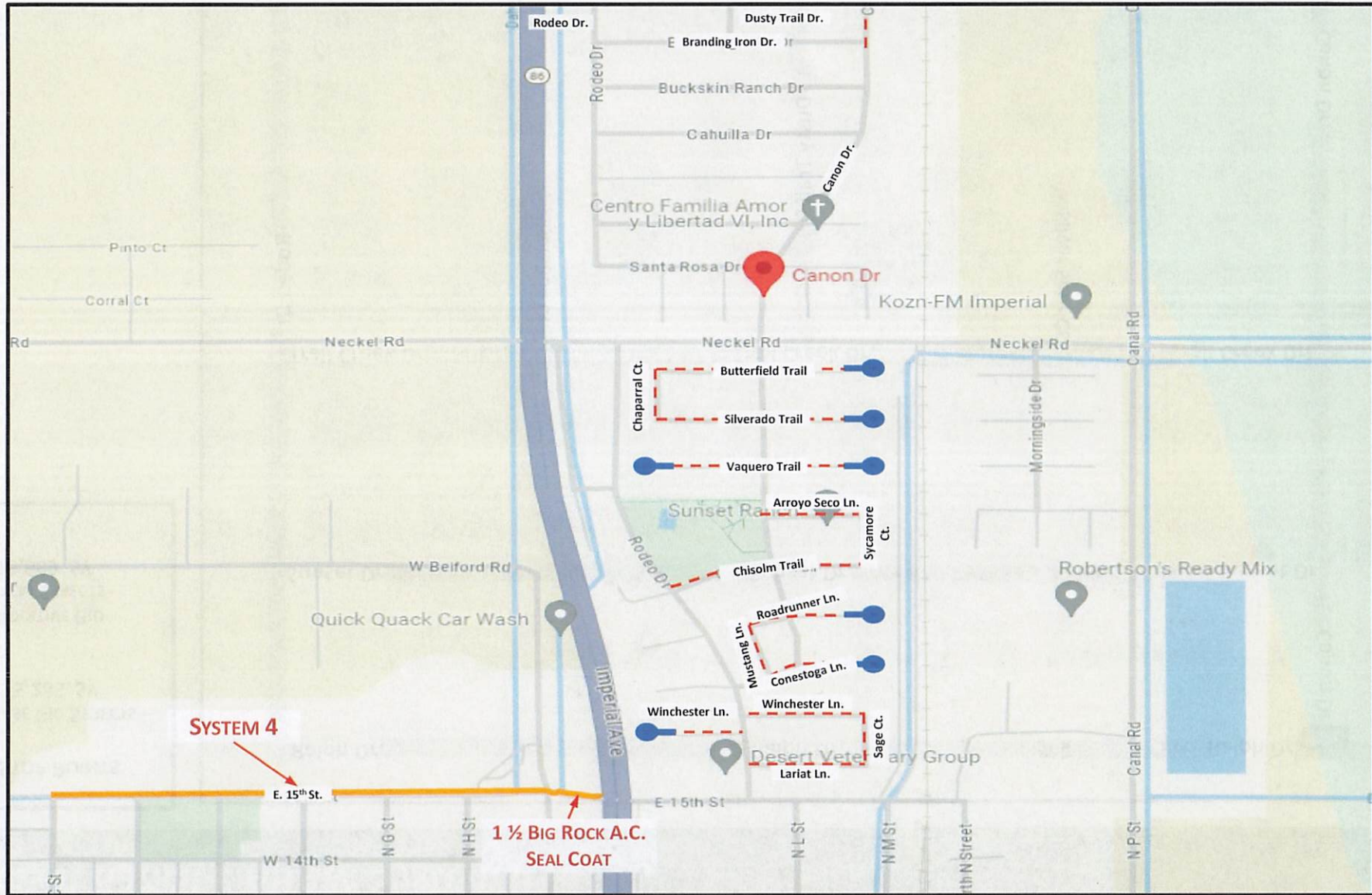

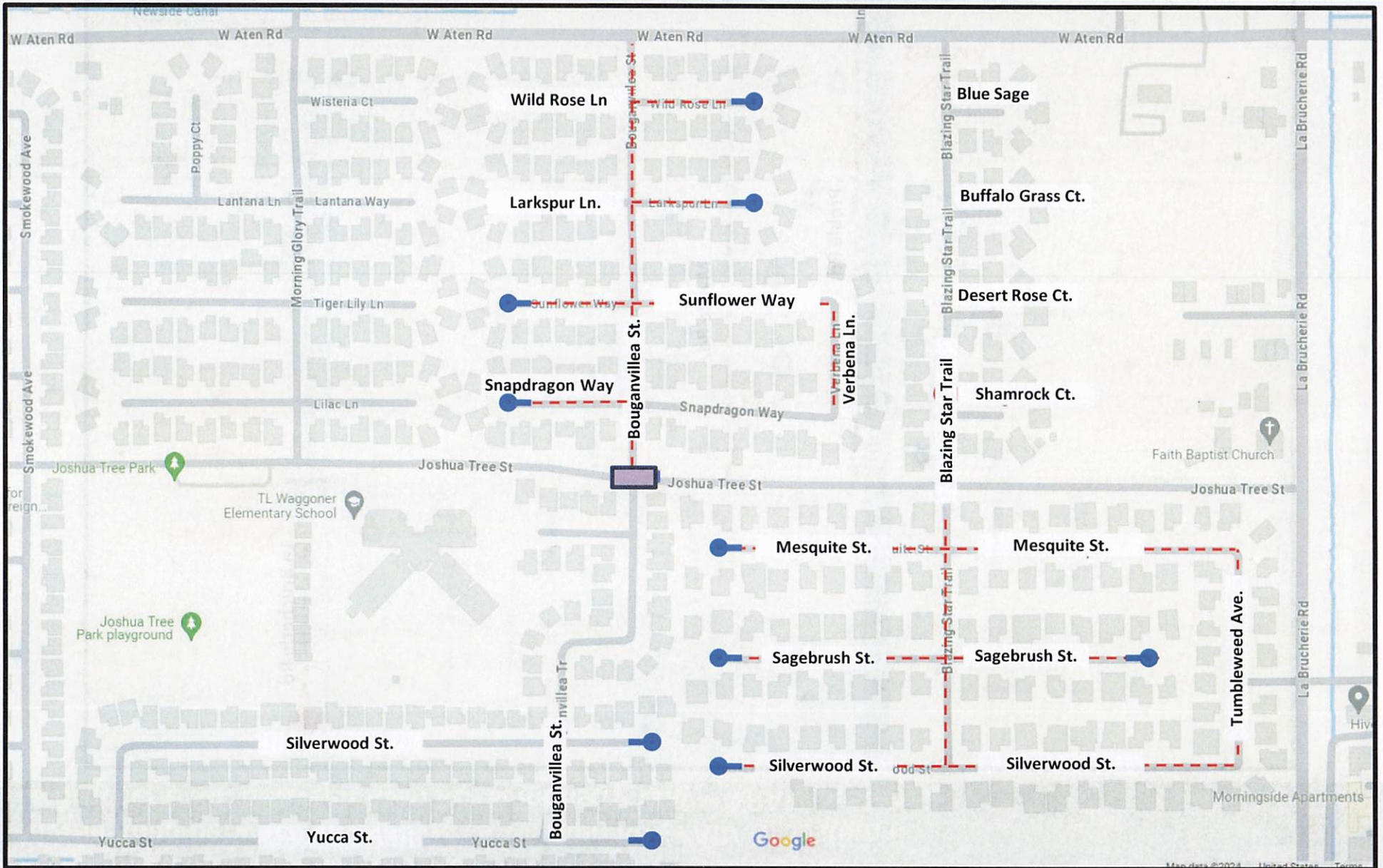

Imperial City Engineers Estimate Sunset Ranch – ARAM System II E. 15th Street – System 4

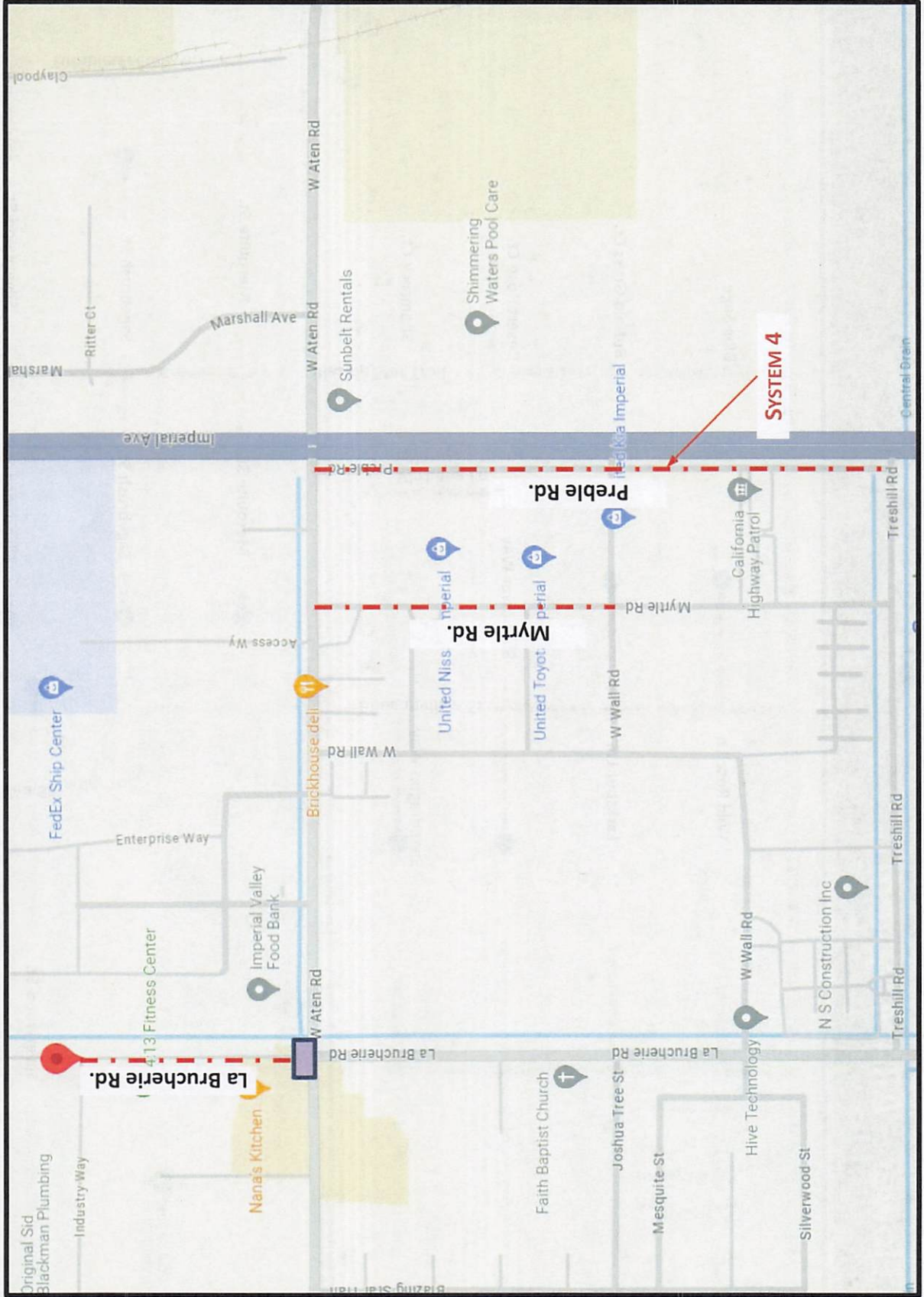

Imperial City Engineers Estimate Wild Flower – ARAM System II

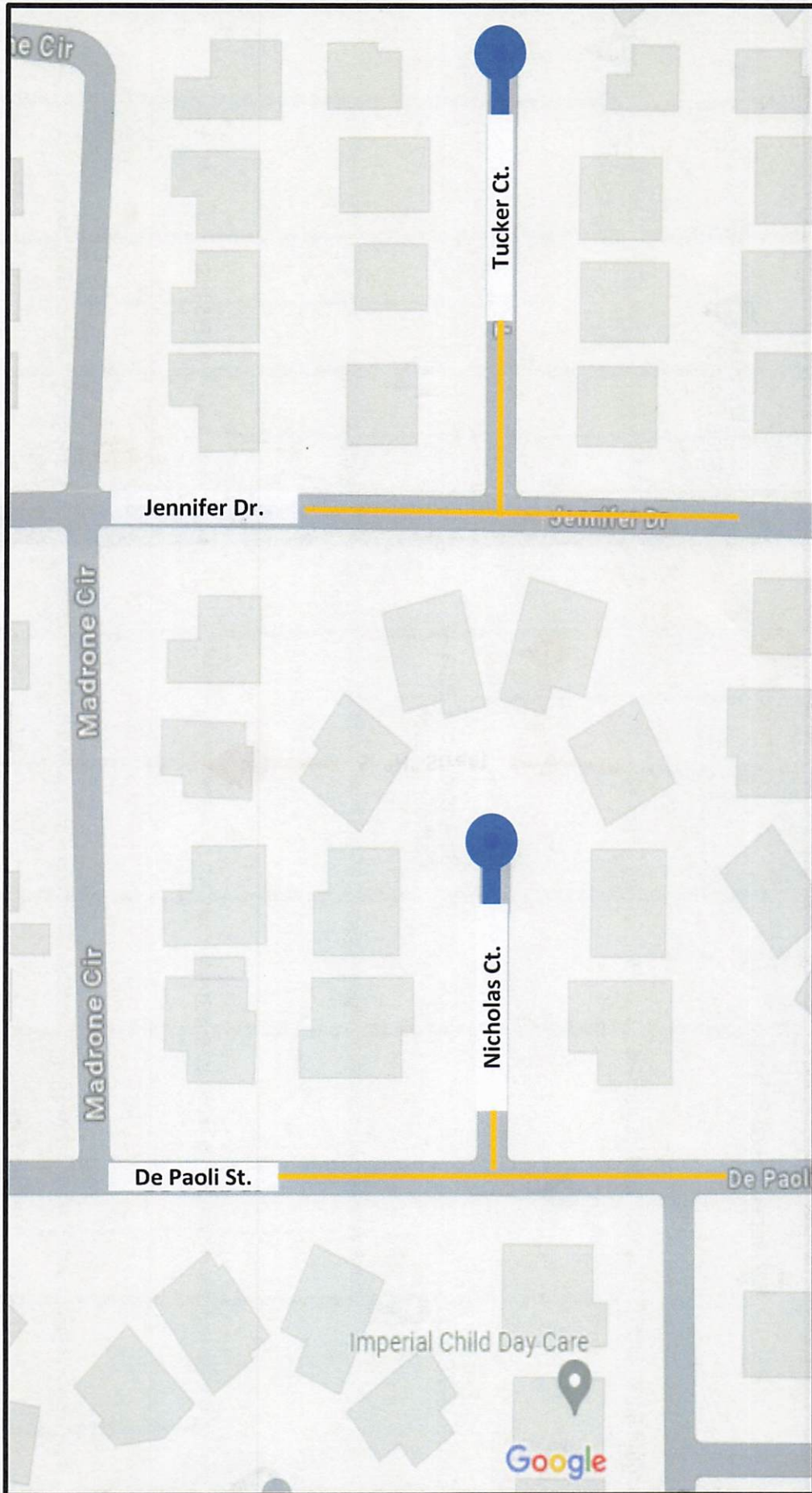

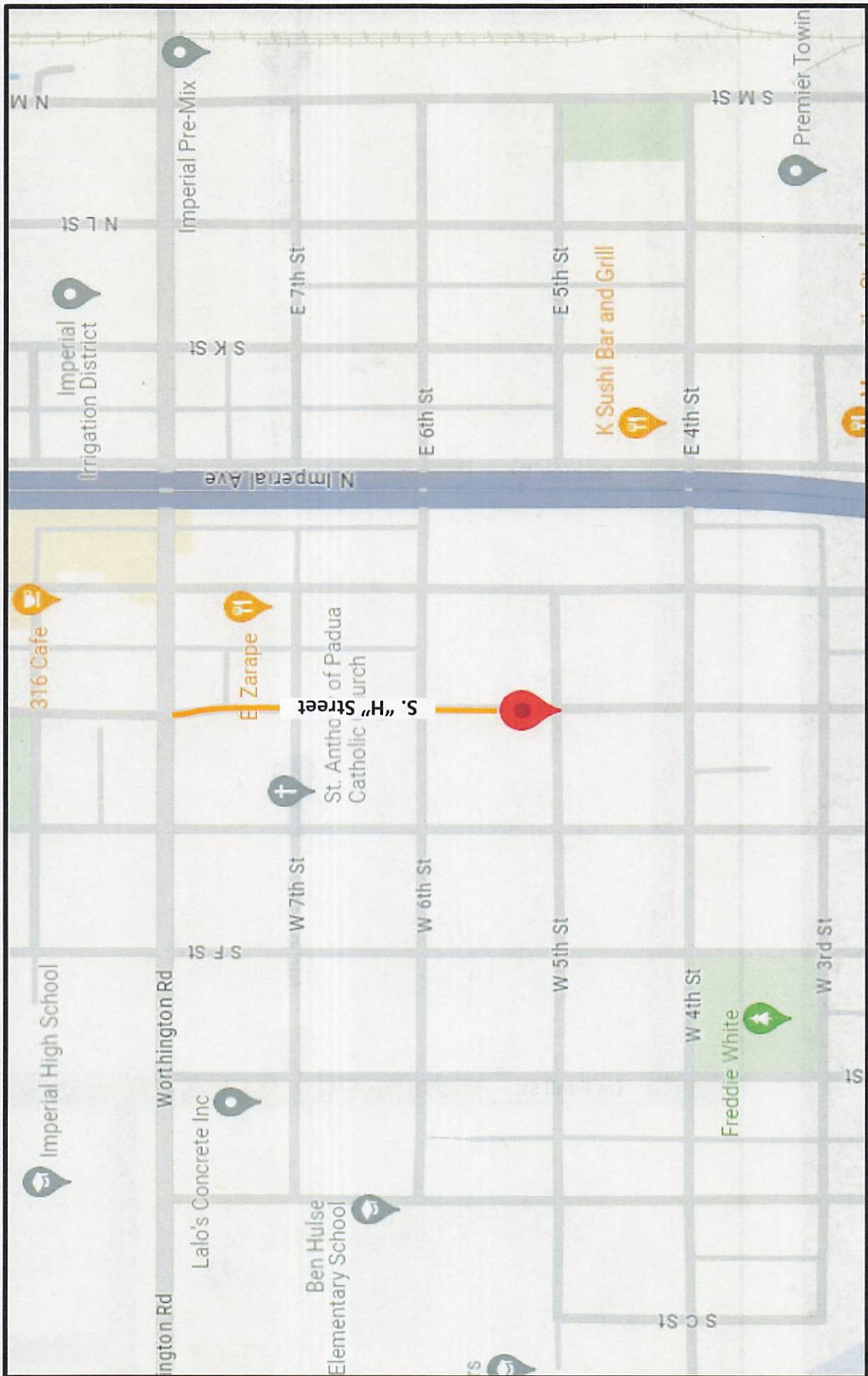
