BACKGROUND/SUMMARY: Adopt Resolution No. 2025-52, authorizing the City of Imperial to accept grant funding from the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) in the amount of \$42,000. The California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) provides grant funding to local agencies to support efforts in reducing traffic-related fatalities, injuries, and collisions. The awarded grant in the amount of \$42,000 will allow the Police Department to enhance traffic safety enforcement and education activities without impacting the General Fund. Funding may be used for officer overtime, training, equipment, and outreach materials directly related to the program.
