SUBJECT: DISCUSSION/ACTION: ACCEPTANCE OF THE PATRICK LEAHY BULLETPROOF VEST PARTNERSHIP GRANT AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,012.64

DEPARTMENT INVOLVED: Police Department

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

The Patrick Leahy Bulletproof Vest Partnership is a federal initiative that provides financial assistance to law enforcement agencies for the purchase of bulletproof vests. The U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) Office of Justice Programs administers the program to help ensure the safety of law enforcement personnel by providing up to 50% of the total cost of body armor.

The City applied for the grant to support the Police Department's purchase of new bulletproof vests, which are a vital component of officer safety. The Police Department is replacing outdated vests to meet current safety standards. The awarded amount of \$6,012.64 will offset the cost of these necessary purchases. On 05/01/2024, Resolution 2024-20 was passed, approved, and adopted for COPS funding in the amount of \$58,989.00 for the purchase of ballistic vests.

The acceptance of this grant will enable the City to improve the safety of its law enforcement personnel without placing additional financial burdens on the General Fund. The matching funds requirement for this grant will be met through the existing Police Department budget.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total grant award is \$6,012.64, which requires a 50% match by the City. The match will be funded from the Police Department's 22/23 COPS funding. No additional appropriations are required.

(COPS) PROGRAM FUNDING FOR FISCAL YEAR
2022-2023**

WHEREAS, the City of Imperial received funding from the State of California Citizens Options for Public Safety (COPS) Program, and is approved for funding for the program in FY 2022-2023 in the amount of \$100,000.02; and


