



SUBJECT: DISCUSSION/ACTION: 1. ACCEPT THE PROJECT AS COMPLETE 2. AUTHORIZE THE RELEASE OF THE 5% RETENTION AND FILING OF THE NOTICE OF COMPLETION WITH THE COUNTY RECORDER'S OFFICE	
DEPARTMENT INVOLVED: PARKS AND RECREATION	
BACKGROUND/SUMMARY: In 2023, the Parks and Recreation Department was awarded the Statewide Healthy Play & Education Funding Initiative. This Initiative provided fifty (50) percent matching funds for the purchase of the all-inclusive playground and fitness equipment. Zasueta Contracting was awarded a bid of \$396,730.00 to build the playground and fitness equipment, add flooring, new sidewalks install two (2) shade structures and install solar lighting. On August 21, 2025, a change order was approved in the amount of \$3,154.00 to fill some of the shade structures' footings with gravel due to the water table. The city has done its final walkthrough, and this project was deemed complete. Construction cost total: \$399,884.00 Please see attached completion letter and project photos
